## **ADVISING ROLE**

- · Serve as an advisor to:
  - o CO
  - o XO Spouse
  - CMC/COB Spouse
  - o Ombudsman
  - o FRG

#### **TEAMBUILDING ROLE**

- preside over the Command Support Team
- prepare agendas and cooperatively plan the work of the team
- plan, organize and delegate activities for wardroom spouses/functions
- attend FRG events
- set a positive tone
- ensure each spouse is seen as a valued member of the command family
- encourage others to contribute
- express appreciation for people coming to events and contributing
- discourage gossip or rumors
- attend command activities with your spouse that include single sailors

### **PLANNING ROLE**

- facilitate development of master calendar for FRG
- facilitate development of activities surrounding deployment

# **COMMUNICATING ROLE**

- Develop and maintain good communications with the following:
  - o leadership team
  - Command Support Team spouses
  - wardroom spouses
  - FRG
- design and maintain the phone tree for the wardroom spouses
- provide accurate and trustworthy information
- notify XO Spouse and Ombudsman when out of town
- leave plans and phone numbers in case of emergency
- make periodic phone calls to families
- greet new members of the command with welcome notes, phone calls or small gifts
- contact families not in the local area
- send cards for special occasions
- submit articles for the ship's newsletter
